This funding will be used to

- Improve teacher capability in the explicit teaching of writing
- Increase the number of students meeting NMS in Literacy and Numeracy to 100%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2B in Writing, Reading and Numeracy in Yr 3 & 5.
- Increase the percentage of students reading at Benchmark 23 at the end of Year 3.
- Increase the percentage of children achieving C+ or better in Literacy and Numeracy from to >85%
- Improve teacher capability through use of effective pedagogies and an improved feedback culture.


Our initiatives include

- Enhance Differentiation practices through review of student performance data in writing, reading and maths.
- Provide targeted explicit teaching/learning programs to support writing across all year levels.
- Data meetings with teachers, and/or HOC, DP and Principal to discuss individual student data and identified strategies.
- Mooloolaba Pedagogical Framework implemented across all year levels.
- Implementing Age Appropriate Pedagogies – Prep 2017.
- Provide teacher release to support coaching and feedback opportunities in each classroom.
- Employing specialist support teachers for early intervention and acceleration programs.
- Provide additional parent workshops to support writing and reading at home.
- Provided targeted professional development with demonstration and modelling utilising evidence-based practices

Additional Teacher Aide hours to support classroom teacher and literacy coaches – focus on building teacher capacity and sustainability of programs.	\$106000
